Each year we offer over 45 classes and serve over 1000 students, ages 1-18, in the BAX Building. Our programs encompass five core values — skill-building, creative choice, collaboration, performance, and community – and include a broad range of youth classes, performances and festivals. At BAX, no student is turned away based on the inability to pay. Our day camps run 9:00 AM - 4:30 PM, with drop-off beginning at 8:00 AM and pick up until 6:00 PM. Kids bring their own lunches, and Beam provides two snacks each day.</p>
