


You need

• deck of Dot Addition Cards




• 3 gameboards (one per player and one to play on)



- Deal 4 rows of 5 cards, with the dots facing up.
- Player 1 finds cards that combine to make one of the numbers on the gameboard.
- Both players record the combination.
- Player 2 finds cards that combine to make another number on the gameboard.
- Both players record the combination.
- The game is over when the gameboard is full.

More Ways to Play

- Play with different gameboards.
- Use each card only once.
- Play again, with the same gameboard. Try to find a different way to make each number.

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Challenging versions of Dot Addition

- Make the numbers larger on the blank game board.
- Divide the game board into 2 or 3 sections (by drawing a line down the middle). Children have to find and record different ways to make the same number in each round.
- Each player explains how he/she knows his/her combination matches the total after each turn.
