




Object of the game To collect the most cards.

Advance Preparation If the Game Masters are being used, players should write the fraction for the shaded part on the back of each card.

- 1. One player deals the same number of cards, fraction-side up, to each player:
 - 2 players: 16 cards each
 - 3 players: 10 cards each
 - 4 players: 8 cards each
- 2. Each player places his or her cards fraction-side up on the gameboard.







- Starting with the dealer, moving in a clockwise direction, each 3. player plays 1 card.
- Cards are placed on the gameboard with the fraction side showing.
- The player with the largest fraction wins the round and takes **5.** the cards. Players may check who has the largest fraction by comparing the amount shaded.
- If there is a tie, each player plays another card. The player with the largest fraction takes all the cards.
- The player who takes the cards starts the next round. The game is over when all the cards have been played.
- The player who has the most cards wins. 8.

Variation

At Grades 2 and 3, only 2 students play the game. Players compare the shaded areas of the cards instead of the fraction numbers.




